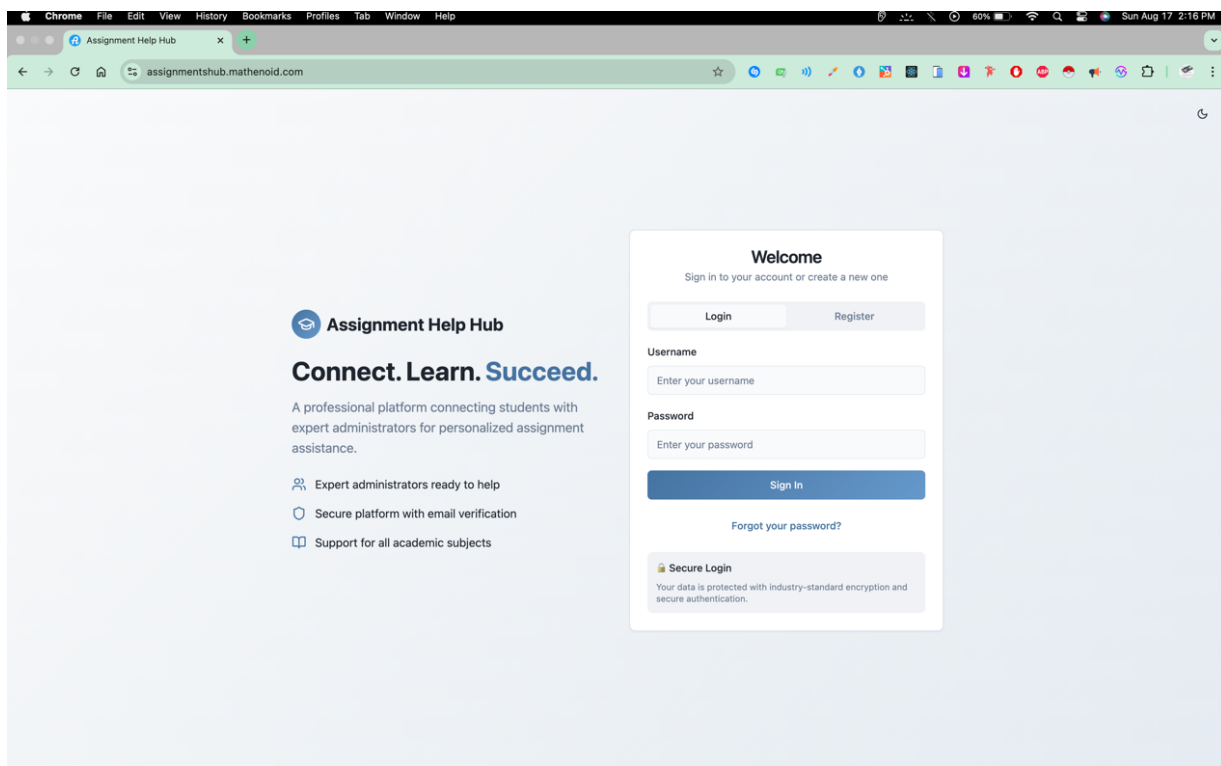

## Step 2. Student Dashboard

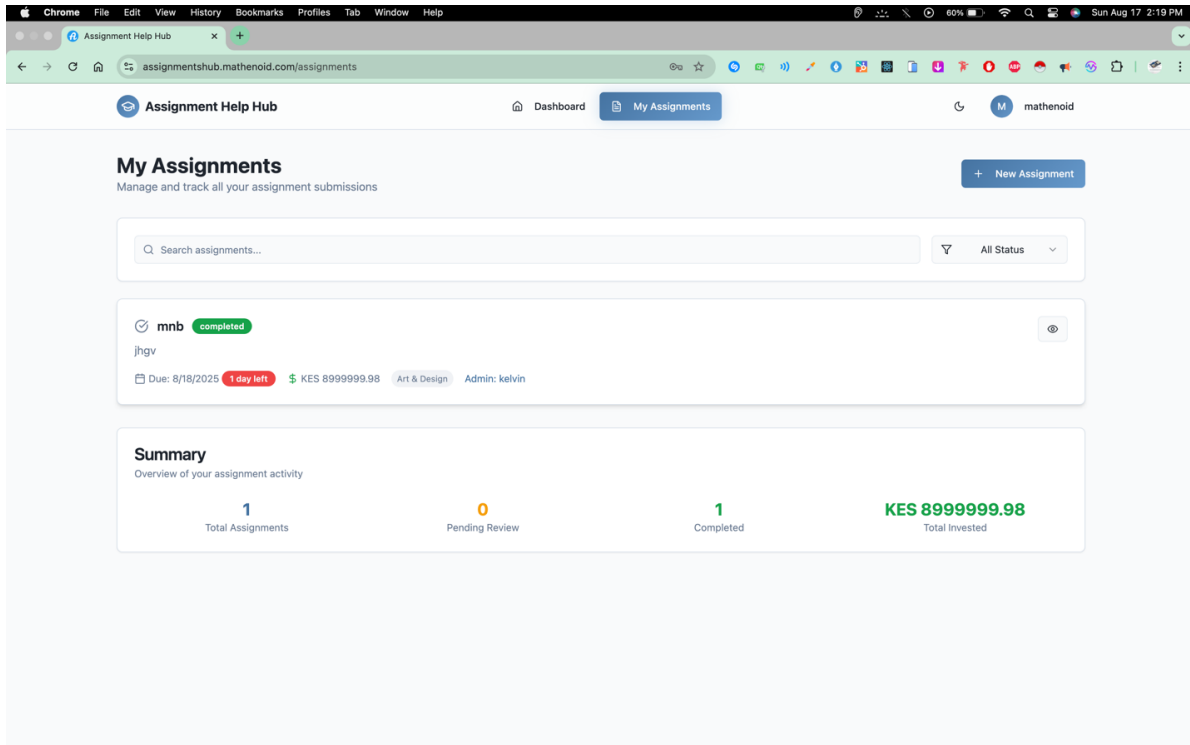
After successful login, you are redirected to the dashboard where you can access various pages and functionalities.

- The profile button with profile, settings and logout functionalities

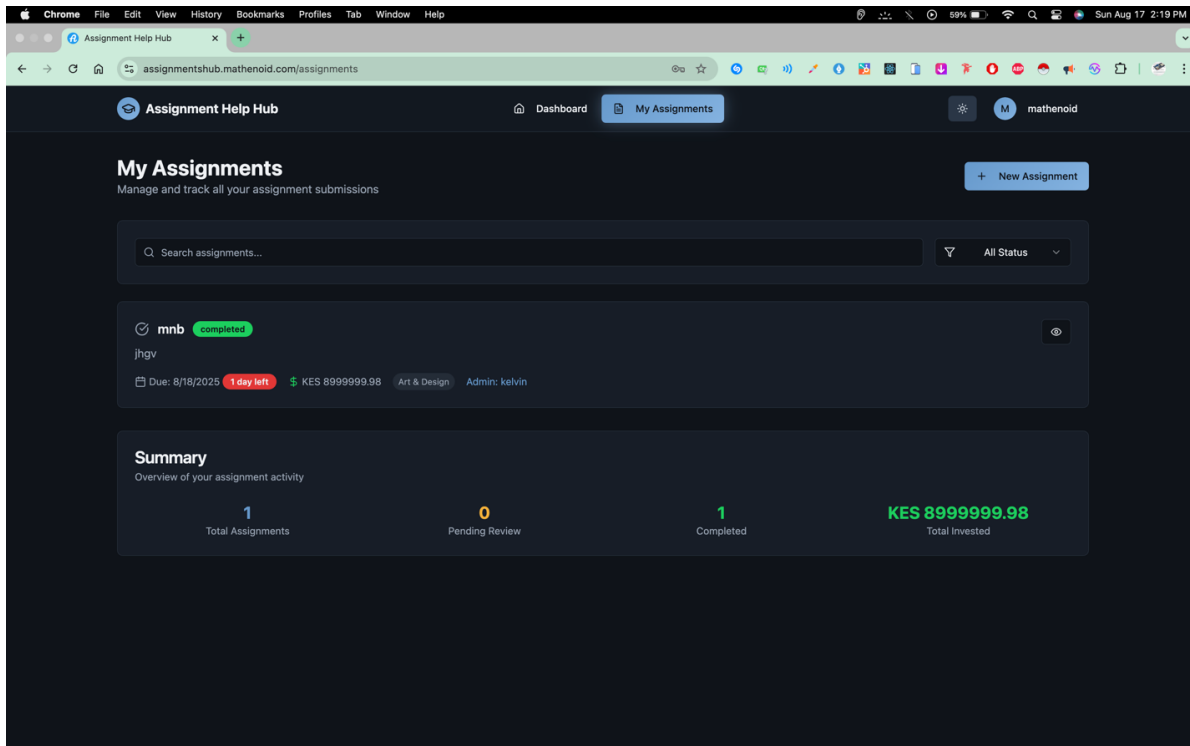

- Upload files in supported formats (PDF, DOC, XLS, Images, etc.)

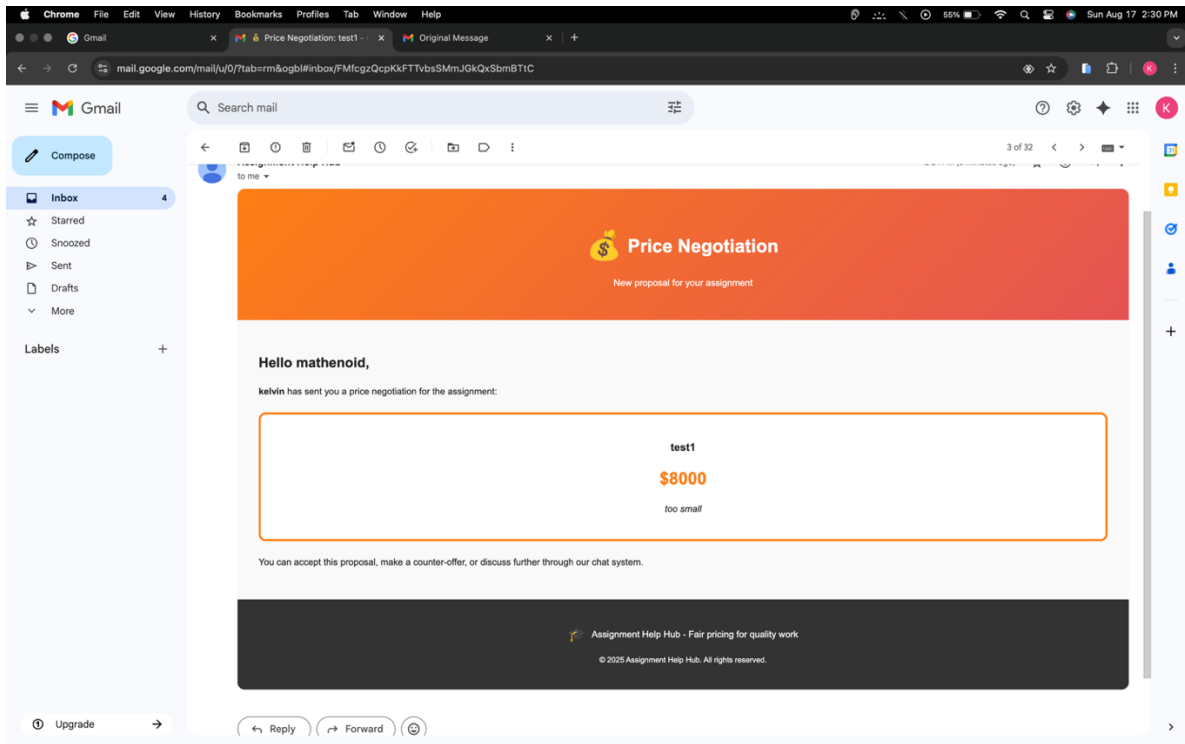
